Advice to students

This course requires attendance on one full day per week. Basic written language skills are essential. TGSS funding requires students to complete 30 hours of work experience. (Includes recognition of past experience).

Course overview

This program will help students become job ready for businesses such as cafes, delis, bakeries, hotels, commercial kitchens, catering, hospitality, restaurants and kitchens in locations such as Aged Care facilities. The training will give students the opportunity to gain key skills and/or recognition in food handling, food preparation, customer service/selling and barista/cafe duties.

Assessment

Assessment is conducted throughout the course in both practical and theoretical activities. Each competency is assessed according to the criteria set in the training package. Students can also apply for RPL.

Pathways

Opportunities exist to gain employment, school-based apprenticeship or continue studying at Certificate III level.
