Course length

Full year options as follows:

- 1 evening per week (5.00pm - 8.00pm) plus external learning component.

Advice to students

An interview is required before enrolment.

High level of interest in working and interacting with children/students is essential. No background knowledge is expected however the course requires good literacy skills.

Additional costs will be incurred for DCSI Child Related Employment Screening check, First Aid and Responding to Abuse and Neglect training.

Course overview

This qualification reflects the role of workers in a range of education settings, including public and independent schools and community education settings, who provide assistance and support to teachers and students under broad-based supervision.

Assessment

This course includes 17 units which are assessed against national competencies of which 12 are compulsory and 5 elective. Tasks are both theoretical and practical in nature. A minimum of 3 work place visits by the assessor is required.

In addition to the classroom time and external component there is a required minimum 100 hours of work placement.

RPL processes available

RPL means an assessment process that assesses an individual's formal and informal learning to determine the extent to which that individual has achieved the required learning outcomes, competency outcomes, or standards for entry to, and/or partial or total completion of, a VET qualification.

Pathways

The course may assist in gaining employment as a School Support Officer or work in an OHSC (out of hours school care). Successful completion of the Certificate III may assist students to gain entry into higher level vocational or tertiary studies.
