

Integrated Learning

(Fashion – Make it, Wear it)

Level: Stage I

Course length: 1 semester

Credit value: 10 Credits

Advice to students

No background knowledge is required.

An interest in designing and producing sustainable fashion and a willingness to participate in making activities as it is an essential component to this subject.

Course overview

This is a school-developed program giving students an opportunity to meet the SACE requirements through designing and producing a range of fashion garments from accessories to clothing. The course is based around practical assignments that will cover fashion illustration, design development and developing a body of work. Activities may include involvement in College events as a focus for planning, organising and participating in Fashion Stall/Exhibitions.

The course has a focus on skill development and collaboration to aid students in developing their planning, organisational, collaborative research, reflecting and analytical skills.

Assessment

- Practical 40%

Teacher observation, self assessment and reflective evaluation on making game activities.

- Group activity 30%

One group project based on planning, organising and participating in Fashion Stall/Exhibitions at MSC.

- Folio and Discussion 30%

Develop a folio to support their learning, discussion between teacher and students about their learning.

Pathways

This subject is a desirable preparation for SACE Stage 2 Creative Arts, Visual Arts – Design and Certificate III in Visual Arts – Textiles.
