This course provides the opportunity to meet the SACE numeracy requirements and has no pre-requisites.

Course overview

Stage I Essential Mathematics focuses on students extending their mathematical skills in ways that apply to practical problem solving in everyday and workplace contexts. Students develop the necessary skills to solve problems in real contexts for a range of workplace, personal, further learning and community settings. This subject provides the opportunity for students to prepare for post-school options of employment and further training.

Topics studied in Numeracy Essential A will include:

- Calculations, Time and Ratio
- Earning and Spending
- Geometry

Topics studied in Numeracy Essential B will include:

- Measurement
- Data in context
- Investing

Assessment

Assessment is conducted through a variety of tasks including for each semester:

- 2 Skills and Application tasks 60%
- 2 Mathematical Investigations 40%

Students who achieve a C grade or better in either semester will meet the compulsory 10-credit numeracy requirement of the SACE.

Pathways

Students gain additional numeracy skills for their studies and future pathways.
