

# Adobe Creative Cloud Login and Install

**Only students that are enrolled in subjects that need to use Adobe software will be given an Adobe login.**


## Complete Account Setup

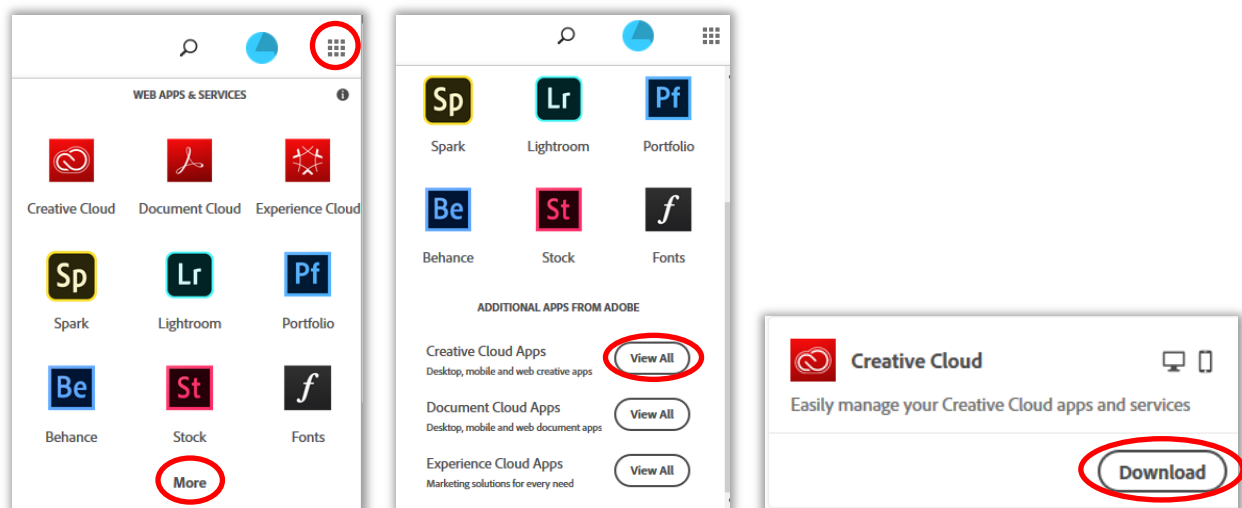
- Login to you school email using [webaccess.msc.sa.edu.au](http://webaccess.msc.sa.edu.au)
- Look for and open the email from Adobe Creative Cloud  
*If you can't find the email from Adobe ask your teacher to contact Help Desk*
- Click on the Get Started link to setup a password for your account  
*Your new password must have at least 8 characters (mix of lower/uppercase) and include a number and a symbol. It cannot match your username or your previous 5 passwords.*


## Login to Adobe.com

- Follow the steps above if you have not set a password for your Adobe account
- Open a web browser (Google Chrome, Firefox, etc.) and visit [adobe.com](http://adobe.com)
- Click Continue to Australia link
- Click Sign In at the top right of the website
- Enter your @msc.sa.edu.au email address on the bottom of your timetable and click Continue
- Enter the password that you set in the [Complete Account Setup](#) section above

## Download and Install Desktop Applications on Personal Devices

- Follow the [Login to Adobe.com](#) instructions above
- Click the Web Apps & Services link at the top right of the website 
- Click on the **More** link
- Click **View All** button
- Find Creative Cloud and click the **Download** button
- Follow the steps to install



- When the install has finished click Take Tour to learn more about Adobe Creative Cloud Desktop app
- Click Install button for all the Apps that you want to install  
The Apps will need to download between 1 and 3 GB each so make sure that you have enough download quota and hard drive space before clicking Install
- After the install you can open the Apps through the Adobe Creative Cloud Desktop app or Start Menu on Windows or Applications folder on Mac 
- You can also Send Link to your mobile and Launch web apps by selecting the Mobile or Web tabs in the Adobe Creative Cloud Desktop app
