Funding Criteria

- Must be in year 11 or 12 and turning 16 in the year of study

- Must not have exhausted personal allocation of government funding

- In year 11 or 12
- Have successfully completed the VETRO process inclusive of Language Literacy and Numeracy Testing
- Attended ANMEC's orientation session in Term 4 2021

Structured Work Placement

Students undertake a minimum of 120 hours of work placement. At ANMEC, these are conducted in 1 or 2 week blocks during school holidays.
